Mathematics	16. Doris Chen Undergraduate Project Prizes	Not more than two undergraduate students majoring in Mathematics who have excellent performance in one of the eligible project courses prescribed by the Doris Chen Memorial Funds Committee.
Mathematics	17. Walter Brown Memorial Prizes in Mathematics	(i) The best student in Mathematics, on the recommendation of the Head of Mathematics, among those completing the BSc 2nd year.
		(ii) The best student in Mathematics, on the recommendation of the Head of Mathematics, among those completing the BSc final year.
Mathematics	18. Wong Yung Chow Prize in Mathematics	The best 3rd year student in Mathematics, on the recommendation of the Head of Mathematics.
Mathematics	19. Y. M. Chen Memorial Prize in Mathematics	The best student in mathematical analysis, among those competing the BSc final year, on the recommendation of the Head of Mathematics.
Physics	20. Lam Chi Him Memorial Prize in Physics	The best Year two student amongst those completing first year of the BSc curriculum in Physics (on the recommendation of the Head of Department of Physics).

Luk Kam-Biu Prize in Experimental Physics	The prize(s) shall be awarded annually to third or fourth year undergraduate students reading for the Bachelor of Science degree in the Department of Physics and, who have attained the best performance in the course "PHYS4999 Physics Project" in the area of experimental physics or astrophysics through clear demonstration of the student's ability in designing, constructing and / or executing an experiment and ideally along with sound skills in data analysis.

Yu Kam Tim Chan Siu Hing Award in Artificial Intelligence and Data Science	Two awards shall be awarded annually to either Year 2 or Year 3 students in the Decision Analytics Major under the Bachelor of Science Programme, or Bachelor of Arts and Sciences in Applied Artificial Intelligence Programme in alternate years, starting from the Decision Analytics Major. The awards shall be awarded on the basis of students' university examination results in the past 2 years, and demonstration of good character and leadership skills.
