## Tuition Fee & Scholarship / Financial Assistance from HKU

## • <u>Tuition fee</u>

Students will pay HKU tuition fees while on exchange.

## • <u>Scholarship/ financial assistance from HKU</u>

To be eligible for a scholarship, participants must obtain a CGPA of <u>3.0</u> or above for the most recent semester before departure for their exchange studies. All eligible applicants are required to provide information about their financial need. International Affairs Office (IAO) will allocate applicants with an appropriate scholarship according to their financial need and academic standing after the confirmation of acceptance by the host institutions.

All eligible participants will be automatically considered for the Scholarship for Semester Exchange. The scholarship amount for **2024-25** is listed below for your reference:
