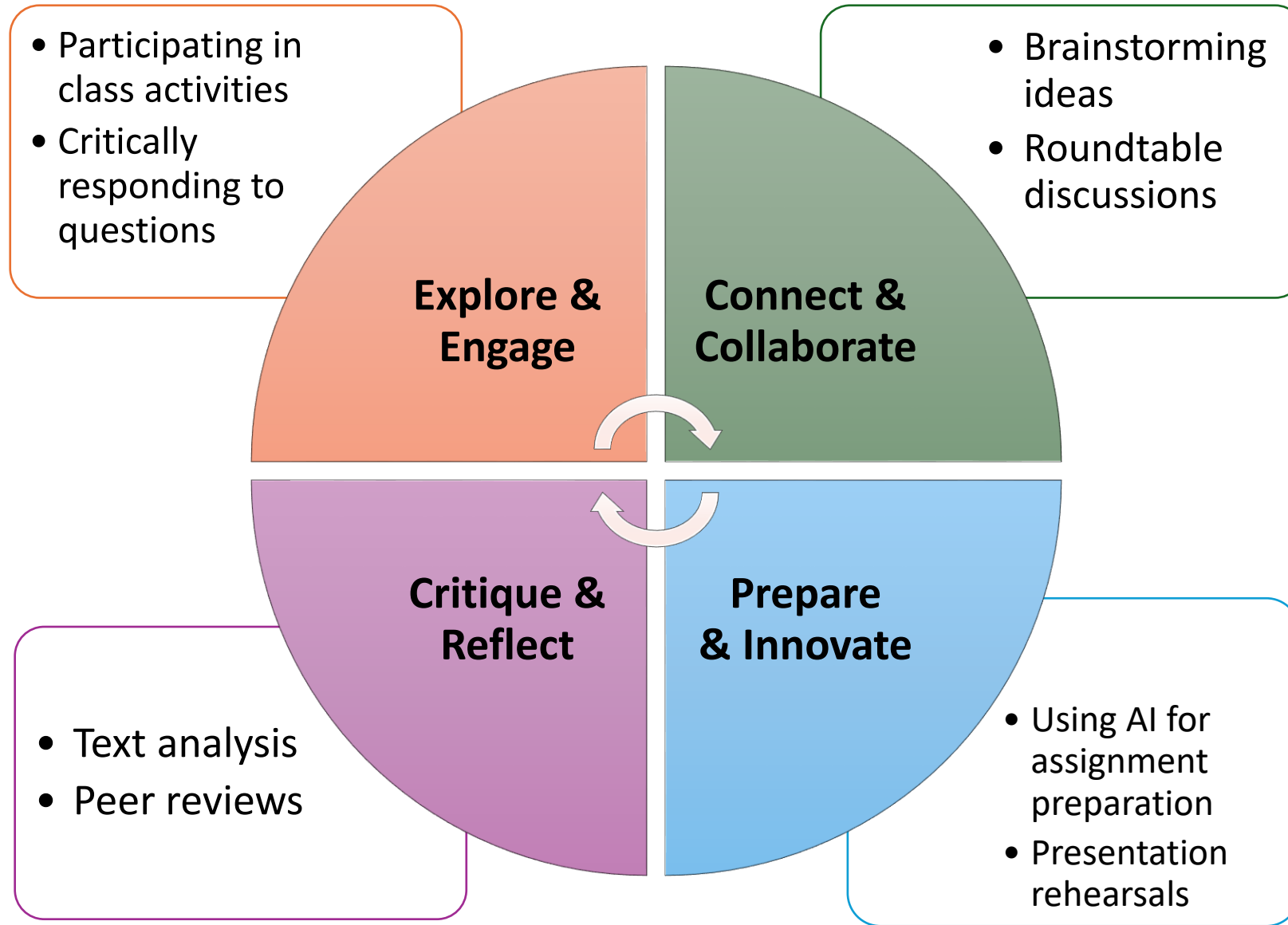

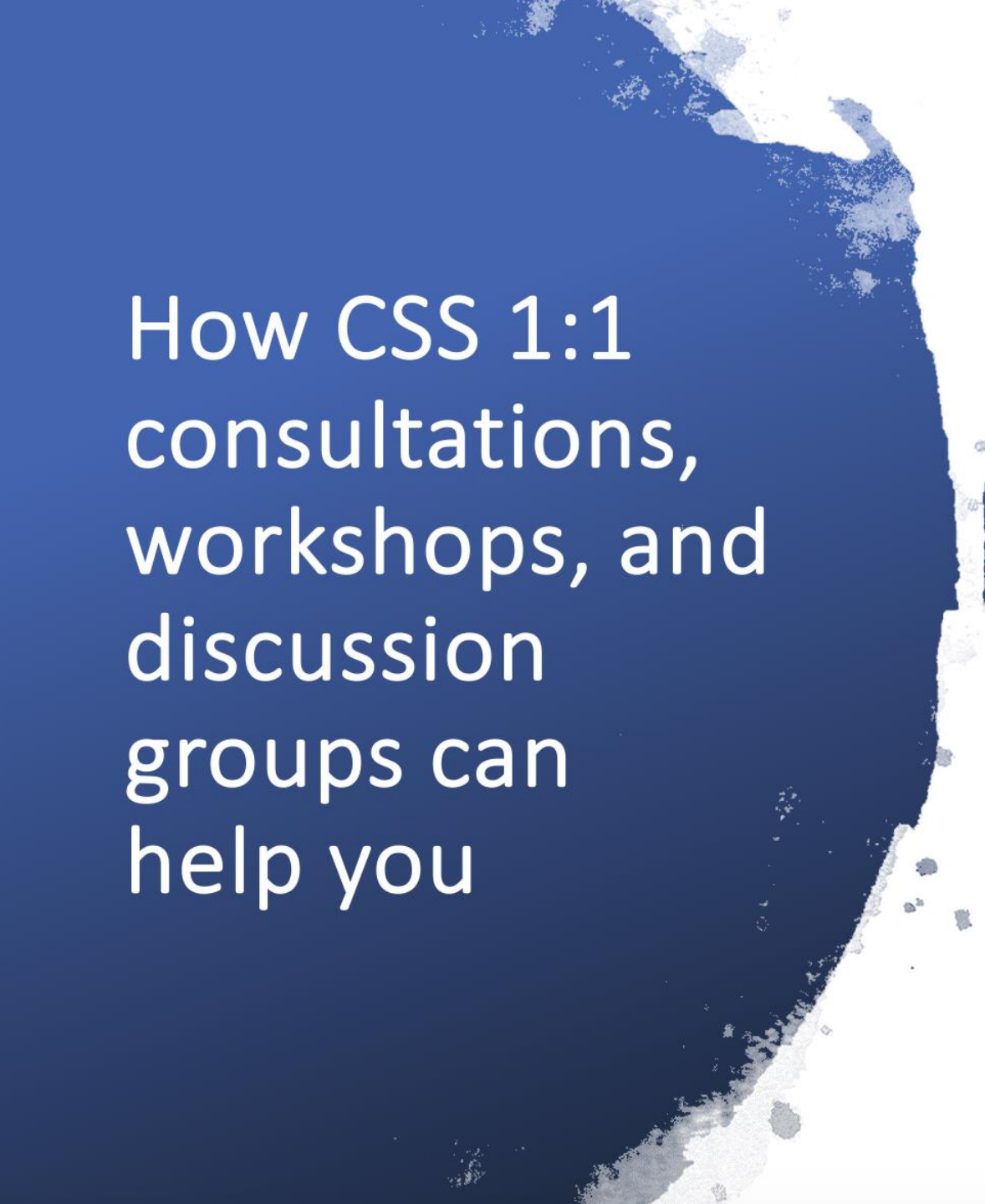

How CSS 1:1 consultations, workshops, and discussion groups can help you

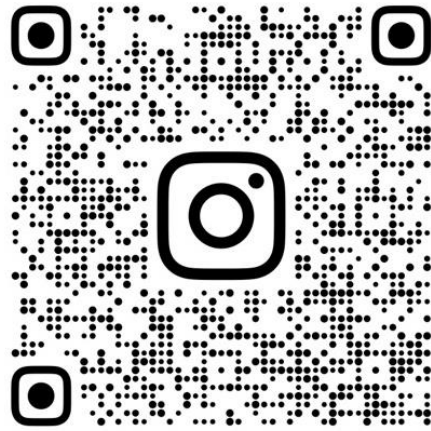
- 1:1 consultations help you resolve content-level issues and teaches strategies for managing surface-level language issues, from brainstorming & planning, to drafting, to polishing your work.
