

Objectives of the Minor

- To create a new career path for students in HKU to excel
 - Building a career in professional fields is more difficult now, e.g.
 - Graduate works in Big 4 accountant firms does not have good starting point (HK\$ 14-18K)
 - Hong Kong government has started to invest a lot of money in innovation and entrepreneurship recently, e.g. extra HKD 50 billion budgeted in 2018
- To equip students to set up more viable business ventures
 - Training students with in-house experienced faculty and external professional trainers
 - Teaching students essentials of business venture with real cases and startup founders
 - Assisting students to build their business ventures starting by writing business plans and investment proposals in the final 6 credits bearing course ENTR4999 "Entrepreneurship Project"

 - develop a business plan to commercialize such a solution for the need, and an investment proposal to attract investors.





Target achievement:

- By working on a specific project in a startup in group or individual
 - Gain hand-on experience on startup operation
 - Learn how to complete a commercial task in a limited time frame
 - Gain opportunity from commercial collaborator to further work on the project that can form a new startup

Course Content

- → 3rd Summer Semester (160 hours in June)
 - ENTR4966 Entrepreneurship Internship
 - **►** Learning from real startup
 - Students group themselves as a 3-4 member team (preferably from different faculty)
 - Each team will be working for a real early stage startup in HK
 - To work on a specific project that setup by a startup company

Selection Criteria for the Intake

- General expectation
 - Students have strong desire and passion to form their own companies
- Bonus points
 - Students have entrepreneurial experience, e.g. forming startup or attending business competitions...etc.
 - Students have already partnered with other students to form a very strong team
 - Students come with an excellent idea/product
- Preferred students
 - Year 2 students
 - ▶ They need to show their specialties, e.g. any of the bonus points mentioned above
 - Year 3 students
 - Complete the Minor in Year 4 -1st Semester then start fund raising in 2nd Semester then graduate
 - Investor will not need to wait for them another year to operate the company
- Can consider
 - Year 4 students
 - They must decide to defer one semester in order to complete the Minor

Selection Procedure of the Minor

- Only 20 seats of this Minor for Students from All faculties
 - Ideally 10 science students + 10 non-science students
- To help students to build a better team, it is recommended for each student to write a one page proposal (to <u>rockylaw@hku.hk</u> any time before 25 July) that shows
 - Who you are
 - Name, Student No., Faculty, Major, Year of Study, email address, Tel No., Date
 - How special you are
 - Why you should be chosen, e.g. because you have
 - Excellent team (Preferably including at least science, engineering, business students)
 - Excellent idea
 - **■** Excellent experience...etc.
- Interviews start from March
- Students will be notified in August at the latest

Remark

- What is required by the University
 - Complete 6 courses in order to get the minor
- My Goal
 - You become my boss in the near future
- My experience and network
 - ► I can help you but you have to convince me first..... As I only have 24 hours a day
- Mutual respect
 - We work as a partner
- You perform
 - It is all based on your performance with your sincere heart
- I observe
 - I don't judge but just observe, as I am also looking for my future boss
