- 3. Programme credit requirement: MSc EG theme 66 credits, MSc HKIE theme 69 credits.
- 4. Students are expected to attend all classes. Reading Weeks are teaching weeks in the timetable. The period of studies of a full-time student starts on the first day of teaching of the academic year and ends on 31 August of the following year. Full-time students are required to obtain permission for any leave of absence from Hong Kong outside university holidays and are strictly forbidden from taking up employment of any kind or internship or attachment of any kind during the period of studies, unless approved by the programme director.
- 5. Part-time students are expected to take courses worth at least 15 credits per semester.

6. Engineering Geology theme (EG theme):

Core courses for students with a first degree in Geology, Earth Sciences or Earth System Science ('Geologists'): GEOS7011, 7012, 7015, 7016, 7020, 7024 (for FT students), 8001, 8002, 8003, 8020, 8021, 8101, 8102, 8104 (for PT students in 2023-4), GEOS8204 – 66 credits. Course GEOS7022 may be substituted for course GEOS8204 if directed by the programme director.

Core courses for students whose first degree is not in Geology, Earth Sciences or Earth System Science ('non-Geologists'):

GEOS7010, 7012, 7015, 7016, 7020, 7021, 7033, 8001, 8002, 8003, 8020, 8101, 8102 - 66 credits.

Engineering Geology with HKIE Approved Courses theme (HKIE theme):

Core courses for all students: GEOS7012, 7015, 7016, 7020, 7024, 8001, 8002, 8003, 8020, 8101, 8102, 8204, 8205, 8206 – 69 credits.
