The Faculty is proud to celebrate the exceptional achievements of our scholars, who continue to set new benchmarks in academic and research excellence. In the 2024 Best Scientists Rankings, four of our Professors and two affiliated Professors have earned a place among the top 100 scientists globally in their respective fields. Position in the ranking is based on a scientist's D-index (Discipline H-index), which take into account only the publications and citation values within a specific discipline.

Adding to these accolades, eight of our esteemed scientists —six academics and two affiliated scholars—have been named 2024 Highly Cited Researchers by Clarivate Analytics. Each researcher selected has authored multiple highly cited papers which rank in the top 1% by citations for their fields and publication year in the Web of Science over the past decade. These accolades serve as a testament to the dedication, expertise, and impactful contributions of our scholars, further solidifying our position as a global leader in academic excellence.

Professor Vivian Wing Wah YAM, Vice-President and Pro-Vice-Chancellor (Global Innovation Centre) (Interim), Philip Wong Wilson Wong Professor in Chemistry and Energy, and Chair Professor of Department of Chemistry, has been awarded the International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry (IUPAC) 2025 Award for Distinguished Women in Chemistry or Chemical Engineering.

The award recognises the significant contributions of women in the fields of chemistry and chemical engineering. Awardees were selected for their excellence in research, distinguished achievements in teaching or education, and demonstrated leadership or managerial excellence in the chemical sciences, with a strong emphasis on leadership and community



Endowed Professorship. Renowned for his work in infrared fluorescence imaging, his research focuses on advancing imagingguided tumour resection and surgical navigation to improve cancer treatment.

The professorship, established through a generous \$15 million donation from Moral Properties Limited, will support Professor Dai's continued contributions to innovation and scientific advancement.

Professor Xuechen LI. Professor of the Department of Chemistry has succeeded to the prestigious position of Morningside Professor in Chemical Biology. This recognition highlights his significant contributions to the interface of chemistry and biology,

particularly his work on biomolecules such as peptides, proteins, and glycans to develop novel therapeutics.

Professor Xiaoming YUAN, Professor of the Department of Mathematics has been awarded the Croucher Senior Research Fellowship 2025.

Renowned for his contributions to artificial intelligence and cloud computing, Professor Yuan has made significant strides in addressing optimisation challenges posed by increasing data volumes and computational complexity. His research seamlessly integrates classical optimisation tools with modern machine learning techniques, resulting in scalable algorithms that bridge theoretical advancements with practical applications.

This fellowship recognises Professor Yuan's exceptional achievements in mathematics and his impactful work in advancing both academic research and industry practices.


SCIENCE SPARKS

As a distinguished academic, Professor Zhao has made significant contributions that have advanced the field of earth

sciences. This appointment stands as a testament to his exceptional achievements, dedication, and commitment to the pursuit of scientific knowledge.





Recognised by their peers, AMS members designated as Fellows of the AMS have made outstanding contributions to the creation, exposition, advancement, communication, and utilisation of mathematics. This year's class was selected from a large and excellent pool of candidates, highlighting the many ways that individuals advance their profession.

> Professor Yi YANG, an Assistant Professor in the Department of Physics, has been recently named the Belinda Hung Outstanding Young Professor, a newly established Outstanding Young Professorship at HKU. His innovative research in nanophotonics and free-electron optics has earned him with significant recognition, culminating in the receipt of the

2024 Xplorer Prize and the Croucher Tak Wah Mak Innovation Award.

As the sole Hong Kong recipient of the Xplorer Prize, funded by the New Cornerstone Science Foundation, Professor Yang's work on free-electronlight interactions has promising applications in quantum light generation, radiation sources, and particle accelerators.

He was also awarded the Croucher Tak Wah Mak Innovation Award for his pioneering research in photonics, specifically his work on 'Nonrelativistic free-electron-light interaction with nanophotonics.' His research holds potential for advancements in electron microscopy and spectroscopy, the generation of entangled electrons and photons for quantum light applications, and the development of integrated free-electron radiation sources and accelerators.

Professor Ziyang MENG from the Department of Physics has received the 2024 Top China Cited Paper Award (Physics) for his research paper, 'Momentum Space Quantum Monte Carlo on Twisted Bilayer Graphene', published in Chinese Physics



This award highlights the ten most cited papers authored by researchers based in China, all ranking in the top 1% of articles published by IOP Publishing. It underscores the widespread impact of Professor Meng's work in the scientific community.
